



Vegetative Cover Taking Root at Sunshine Canyon Landfill

SYLMAR, Calif. (Feb. 9, 2018) – In December, the Sunshine Canyon Landfill team announced completion of our final 2017 project, establishing vegetative cover over 57 acres of the Landfill to prevent erosion and soil thinning, and to act as a natural bio-filter. We are pleased to report that due to recent rains and our ongoing irrigation efforts, the vegetation we planted last winter has begun sprouting. We will continue irrigating through the end of March and anticipate a full slope of green vegetation by spring.
